PRELIMINARY PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

The Corporation Commission of the State of Oklahoma (the "Commission") being regularly in session and the undersigned Commissioners being present and participating, there comes on for consideration the Initial Screening Conference conducted March 25, 2009, pursuant to OAC 165:5-11-2.1 in the above-styled matter.

After hearing statements of counsel and being fully advised in the matter, the Commission finds that this cause is legislative in nature and will be treated as such.

The Commission further finds that this matter shall be set before the Commission *en banc* with Administrative Law Judge Maribeth D. Snapp serving as the Referee for this cause.

The Commission further finds that all motions shall be set for hearing before the Referee in Courtroom 301. Additionally, the Referee will make all rulings related to procedural matters.

The Commission will issue a Procedural Order in this Cause at a later date that will address discovery and the procedural dates for hearing that will provide parties an opportunity to submit written comments to the Commissioners and all parties regarding a draft final order to be circulated by the Referee. The Procedural Schedule will also identify dates for the filing of any hearing briefs and provide for closing arguments.

The Commission further finds that the Commission and/or Referee may utilize a technical advisor in this cause.


The Commission further finds that it is vested with jurisdiction over this cause pursuant to Art. IX, Section 18 of the Okla. Const., 17 O.S. §§ 152 and 153, 17 O.S. §§ 250 *et seq.*, 17 O.S. §§ 281 *et seq.*, OAC 165:70, and OAC 165:35.

The Commission further finds that the Preliminary Procedural Order and the general provisions set forth herein shall be adhered to by the parties until or unless modified by a subsequent Commission order.


ORDER
